Seven Actors play all the parts, can easily add more if you have them. It's best if the Stage Manager can actually be played by a crew member, but I've included that role in the actor count just in case that's not possible. The character name is listed and then the role they are currently play is listed in parentheses, for example Issac (God). The character assigned to the role of Issac is playing God in that line.

ACT 1: Genesis 1-25 (The stories of Adam, Eve, Tower of Babel, Noah - kind of, Abraham, Sarah, Hagar, and Isaac)

Scene 1

Issac (God): In the beginning, God created the Heavens and Earth—all you see, all you don't see. Earth was a soup of nothingness, a bottomless emptiness, an inky blackness. God's Spirit brooded like a bird above the watery abyss. The God said, "Let there be Light"

Lights up on someone sitting in the chair.

HG: OK, first off, I did not "brood". I... hovered. And you're being a little dramatic, I think you're scaring people. You know what, why don't I just take it from here... (to audience) Hello, welcome to our show. I am the Holy Sprit and I'll be your tour guide this evening. So, let's get started. (He pulls out a clip board) Let's see, what do we need? We already got light. Thanks, Light Guy (the lights flicker) Next we have water. (2 cast members walk in with long blue material and place it on the stage.) Next was Land (2 cast members walk in with long brown material and place it on stage. As each of the next items are mentioned, the cast brings them on stage) and with that land came seeds which brought plants and trees and flowers and food... man, I love food. I mean I've never actually eaten any, but it smells really good up here. Next we have the sun, moon, stars and the seasons. (4 cast members cross the stage, dressed as the seasons, and wave). Then we have fish, then we have land animals, and last but certainly not least, we have this guy. (Adam enters).

Adam: Hi!

HG: And God saw all that He made and said,

Issac (God): What are you wearing?

HG: That's not what you said.

Adam: Business Causal.

Issac (God): and HG: Why?

Adam: Would you prefer I be dressed the way Adam was really dressed? Because I can do that (*he starts to unbutton his shirt*)

HG: NO! No, we're good. Business casual it is. And God said...

Issac (God): It is good.

HG: Then God made a beautiful garden full of wondrous things and said to Adam:

Issac (God): You can eat anything you want except fruit from the middle tree. If you eat from the middle tree, you will die.

HG: Got it? Middle tree equals death. Say it with me.

Adam and HG: Middle tree equals death.

Adam: Got it! (*he continues to say this to himself*) **HG**: And God asked Adam to name all the creatures...

Adam: Wait... all of them?

HG: Yes.

Adam: Those things up in the air?

HG: Yup.

Adam: And those weird slimy things in the water? (maybe point to the audience)

HG: Uh huh.

Adam: And those things with teeth (We hear a roar off stage and Adam runs and hides behind HG.)

HG: Those too.

Adam: And – ick- whatever those things are...(stomps on a bug and kills it. God rolls his eyes and makes another one.)

HG: That's what "All of them" means. (*HG hands him a clipboard*) Better get started. (*Adam sighs and takes the clipboard*) This could take a while. Let's get some housekeeping out of the way. Please take a moment to silence your cell phones, or better yet, turn them off! The Big Guy isn't a fan of people looking at their phones while we're trying to tell his favorite story. Video and photography are allowed as long as there is NO flash. We're the only ones who get to create light. And there will be a 10-minute intermission later on in the play.

Adam (comes running to HG and hands him the clipboard): Done!!

HG (*looking over it*): Blue Footed Booby? Really?

Adam: I was running out of options. There are 9,000 different kinds of birds alone. 9,000 kinds of birds!!!

HG: Ok, ok. Good job, Adam. Now, how about take a nice long nap.

Adam: But I'm not sleepy! (HG touches him on the shoulder and he falls on stage sound asleep.)

God: It is not good for man to be alone. I will make him a companion. (Eve enters and Adam wakes up)

Adam: Whoa.. Man. Thank you, Lord, for this perfect helper.

Eve: Excuse me?

Adam: Uh.... companion?

Eve: That's better. (She kisses him on the cheek and he takes the clipboard and sits)

HG: All was going swimmingly until this jerk showed up. (*Enter the serpent*.)

Pharoah (Snake): Hey girl, what's going on?

Eve: Oh, hi snake. Nothing much, just doing some meal planning.

Pharoah (Snake): Those are some yummy looking strawberries. Is that going to be lunch again today?

Eve: It is. And I'm thinking of paring them with these blueberries.

Pharoah (Snake): Cool. Yeah, sounds great. It also sounds a lot like what you had for lunch yesterday.

Eve: Oh, no. Yesterday we had strawberries and RASPBERRIES. Totally different.

Pharoah (Snake): Don't you ever get bored of eating the same thing over and over?

Eve: No. We have tons of options here to eat.

Pharoah (Snake): You know what looks good? That tree in the middle.

Eve: Oh, we can't eat that one. Adam said that God told him that if we eat that tree, we'll die.

Pharoah (Snake): You won't die. God doesn't want you to eat from that tree because if you do, you'll be like him. He's holding out on you, girl.

Eve: I find that hard to believe. God has taken exceptional care of us since the day we came into being.
